World Council of Churches Meeting

WHEREAS delegates to previous annual meetings of the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches have expressed their hearty disapproval of and opposition to the unscriptural program of the World Council of Churches; and

WHEREAS loyal Americans have a right to expect their country to erect rigid barriers against invasion, even invasion in the name of religion under the guise of Christian representation at the Second Assembly of World Council of Churches in Evanston, Illinois, in August;

BE IT RESOLVED that the delegates to the 23rd Annual Meeting of the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches strongly urge that our State Department prohibit the entrance to this country for the coming World Council Assembly of such known Communists and Communist sympathizers as Professor Joseph Hromadka of Czechoslovakia and Albert Bereczky of the Hungarian Reformed Church.

WE FURTHER RESOLVE that we unite in the plea to Bible-believing, Bible-loving Christians throughout the world to expose the modernistic and socialistic programs of the Evanston Assembly of the World Council of Churches and to hold high the standard of Biblical separation from such religious and political apostasy.
