In view of the critical situation confronting our nation, as well as the free nations of the world, and in the further view of the bold and unpatriotic assaults being made by the Communists upon the House Un-American Activities Committee of our Congress,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED first, that we, the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches, meeting at Winona Lake, Indiana, this 23rd day of June, 1961, do hereby declare our unswerving loyalty to this blessed country of ours and express our firm purpose to support all the traditional and customary procedures of our government; and

Second, that we commend the work being done by the House Un-American Activities Committee in their exposure of subversive organizations and their efforts and movements in this country; also for their loyalty in the performance of their duties as committed to them by the Congress in accordance with the Constitution of the United States of America.
