Church Union

WHEREAS there has been a growing trend to try to unite all churches in a world union of churches, thus bringing about the consolidation of all communions, Catholics, Protestants, Russian Orthodox and many lesser groups, into one overall organization;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches, assembled in our 31st annual conference in Springfield, Massachusetts, May 14–18, 1962, reaffirm our positive and unyielding loyalty to the Word of God as our absolute and final authority in all matters of faith and practice, and that we hereby declare to all of our churches our deep conviction regarding this matter, separating ourselves from all those who would sacrifice our historic Baptist faith for organizational unity, and that we reaffirm our stand as orthodox, Bible-believing Baptists without compromise at all.
