Hotel/Motel Pornography

WHEREAS pornography serves as a modern tool of the Evil One whereby he devastates a society and arouses in the hearts of mankind the most injurious and heinous of sins; and

WHEREAS pornography is increasingly common on television, and especially in some cable programming; and

WHEREAS some hotels/motels engage themselves in pornographic peddling, providing in-room pornographic movies;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that we, the messengers of the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches, meeting for our 59th Annual Conference in Niagara Falls, New York, June 25–29, 1990, call upon God's people everywhere to refuse to choose immoral and pornographic television viewing, to refuse to subscribe to certain television cable outlets that major in such programming, to write to government agencies and public networks expressing outrage at video trash, and, if at all possible, to take issue with those hotel/motel establishments that provide pornographic services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, given the filthiness of the age, we encourage God's people to purity of life, avoiding fornication and all uncleanness, that should not be once named among us, as becometh saints.
