BE IT RESOLVED that we, the messengers of the churches in fellowship with the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches, meeting in Annual Conference at Winona Lake, Indiana, June 23–27, 1975, offer thanksgiving to God for these approved schools, and acknowledge their significant contribution to the work of the Lord and particularly to the witness of separatists Baptists; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we call to the attention of our churches the urgent need of generous and regular financial support from the churches, especially in the light of current national economic problems, and because of the large and growing need of trained Christian personnel in various walks of life and particularly in full-time Christian service.
